EQUIPMENT RENTAL POLICIES

Note: this is a copy of the equipment rental contract text

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Renter agrees to indemnify and hold Pollution, LLC harmless for any and all damages or injuries caused by use or transport of this equipment. Motion picture equipment can be dangerous even when used correctly, and should only be operated by trained, qualified personnel.

LOSS AND DAMAGE

The renter is financially responsible for all lost and damaged equipment. All rented equipment will be assumed to be in good condition, and all counts will be assumed to be accurate unless specifically noted on the rental form or in writing at time of equipment checkout. It is the responsibility of the renter to inspect and count all pieces of equipment before signing any rental agreement. Lost or destroyed equipment will be billed at replacement value. Damaged equipment will be charge for repair parts and labor, as well as any applicable cleaning fees. This includes equipment damaged during transportation to and from Pollution by the Renter, as well as replacement costs on any equipment that has been lost, stolen or confiscated.

DEPOSIT

Renter authorizes Pollution, LLC to take a security deposit, and to use that deposit to cover any fees damage/loss or late returns. Pollution, LLC agrees to return any unused portion of the deposit within a reasonable period of time.

SPARE GLOBE REPLACEMENT

Spare globes for all lamps are provided free of charge. Globes have an average lifespan of well over 100 hours, as a result, a production will only be issued one free globe per head as a replacement. Replacement globe costs will be assessed if: the bulb burns out as a result of mishandling by the renter, the burned out globe is not returned or if the renter requires more than one replacement per head.

SPECIAL NOTES ON RAGS AND GREEN SCREENS

At no time are actors or crew to stand on or put equipment on top of flags, rags or green/blue screens. This equipment is very difficult and expensive to clean, and if torn or stained must be completely re-covered.
